RESOLUTION**

**Centralized Basic Training of Peace Officers in Georgia
at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center**

WHEREAS, Quality, standardized, basic training of peace officers in Georgia is vital to the law enforcement profession; and

WHEREAS, The Georgia Public Safety Training Center has the overall responsibility for providing and monitoring quality training to Georgia's law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that this quality basic training is made available to Georgia's law enforcement continuously, without fail, in a timely fashion; and

WHEREAS, The Georgia Public Safety Training Center provides an exceptional training environment with superior facilities found nowhere else in the state of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, This central training concept can be a cost saver to the state by relieving the burden on regional academies so that they can concentrate on specialized local training needs; and

WHEREAS, A central location, easily accessible, with housing and meals, is a great cost saver to participating law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, A standardized basic law enforcement training curriculum ensures uniform basic training throughout the state; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police strongly recommends that the Georgia Public Safety Training Center be granted the responsibility of providing, on site, the basic law enforcement training curriculum to Georgia's law enforcement officers.
